
Supplementary Figure 1. Physical health and sex typicality judgments across Experiments 1 and 2.

Supplementary Figure 1. Physical health and sex-typicality judgments across Experiments 1 and 2. The top panels show results from the forced-choice task. The percentage of times that the low SDRT composite was chosen is displayed. A score higher than chance performance (50%) indicates a preference for low SDRT faces when judging physical health or sex-typicality. The bottom panels show results from ratings data. For the ratings data, a difference score is presented (high SDRT ratings subtracted from the low SDRT ratings). Thus, a positive score represents a higher rating for low than high SDRT.
